STATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Every resident of the State of Ohio is eligible for a State scholarship. Below is a list of the scholarship options:

- **Cleveland Scholarship** \$6,166 K8 / \$8,408 HS
- **EdChoice Traditional** \$6,166 K8 / \$8,408 HS
- **EdChoice Expansion** Income based up to \$6,166 K8 / \$8,408 HS
- **Jon Peterson** Special needs based on category \$9,585 to \$32,445
- **Autism Scholarship** Special needs award up to \$32,445

ANGEL SCHOLARSHIPS

Award Amount: Varies by school
Deadline: Set by each school

In the 2024-25 academic year, about \$5.5 million was distributed to students.

These scholarships are made possible through contributions to the Angel Scholarship Fund, a state tax-credit program that is being managed by the Catholic Community Foundation and the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland. Every family that wishes to be considered for an award must complete an online application form.

DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE (DTA)

Award Amount: Varies according to need
Deadline: March 15, 2025

Diocesan Tuition Assistance (DTA) is available to students attending a participating school within the Diocese of Cleveland. Funds are awarded based on financial need. **In the 2024-25 academic year, about \$4 million was distributed to students.**

Families with students attending Benedictine, Cleveland Central Catholic, Elyria Catholic, Holy Name, Lake Catholic, St. Joseph Academy, St. Martin de Porres, Trinity, & Villa Angela-St. Joseph High Schools should contact the school directly to apply for Diocesan Tuition Assistance funds.

FUND A DREAM SCHOLARSHIPS

Award Amount: \$2,500
Deadline:- March 15, 2025

Fund A Dream is an innovative scholarship program that offers a special opportunity for sponsors to "adopt a student" and be provided with updates about them during the school year. All students K-12 that have a remaining financial need of at least \$2,500 are eligible to apply.

SCHOOL EMPLOYEE TUITION ASSISTANCE FUND

Award Amount: Based upon the number of applications received
Deadline: March 15, 2025

Renewed for a eighth year in the 2025-26 academic year, this fund is an additional tuition assistance opportunity for full-time Catholic school employees of the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland whose children are K-12 students.

SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The following scholarships have special requirements and are subject to change from year to year. **Deadline for all applications is March 15, 2025.** Please see the guidelines on the individual applications for the most current information.

Bishops' Scholarship for Excellence: Ten \$3,500 scholarships for high school students and twenty \$1,200 scholarships for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students in participating schools within the Diocese of Cleveland.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

Available: Nov. 1 - May 1 during the school year

Emergency Tuition Assistance Grants are available to families with children in elementary and/or high schools in the Diocese of Cleveland, who are experiencing a major family crisis and cannot meet their tuition obligation. The school should discuss options available to the family at the local level first. This may include a payment plan and/or local financial assistance.
